She has rented 2 tents, one for market animals sale. Also talked about were 4H work days, and where to set up for open class entries. Entertainment main line up will be Hwy 41 band on Friday and Alec Davis on Saturday. Also horse pulls, Elvis, Farmer Donnie, etc. were discussed. Food vendors will hopefully include Gyros, Taco King, J&T Pitstop, kettlecorn and hopefully more. Also trying to figure out where to put non-profit and other vendor spaces. Sponsor letters are going to be sent out in hopes of obtaining new 2021 fair sponsorships.

Old Business: The electricity is back on at the fairgrounds. M. Drobnik will find out if we will start being billed again or if the county is going to handle this.

New Business: Bev Brayton asked if she can open the Old School during the 2021 Antique Expo. She was told that this was ok as long as she also opens it for the fair this year.. M. Drobnik asked if anyone was interested in a having a float for the 4th of July parade. If not, Dean Kirth volunteered to advertise the fair with his Draft Horses/Pull float.
